

THINGS TO KNOW ABOUT EAGAN

- Minnesota's 8th largest city covering 33 square miles
- 67,500 residents live in Eagan
- It's a 2nd ring suburb south of the Minnesota River
- Its 15 minutes from the airport and about the same from Minneapolis and St. Paul.
- GREEN with 4,550 acres of open space.
- FAMILY FRIENDLY CITY with Cascade Bay Outdoor Water Park slides, along with a Lazy River float and Mini Golf
- Trapp Farm Park has a tubing hill and fishing dock
- The HOLZ FARM settled in the 1870's, it is a living history farm and has events year round.
- More than 50 city parks, Caponi Park has many special events
- 130 miles of walking trails
- 30 Soccer fields.
- 79 Softball diamonds
- BMX bike and skateboard parks
- 350 lakes and ponds.
- Eagan Facilities; Eagan Community Center, Full service YMCA, Medical and Dental Clinics, Park & Ride, Eagan Transit Station, City Hall, Wescott (Dakota County) Library, and Eagan Civic Arena with 2 nice rinks.
